The Childcare Coordinator will support the Stoudamire's programming by offering developmentally appropriate activities in a safe, caring environment for children whose guardians are on-site.

Job responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Creating compelling, culturally appropriate activities for children of all ages who visit on a drop-in and regular basis
- Maintaining the cleanliness, organization, and accessibility of the childcare room for all participants and their families
- Fostering a welcoming, positive environment for children and adults through open, friendly communication
- Serving as the first point of contact for guardians via phone, email, and in-person
- Providing supervision and direction to children during center hours
- Collaborating with members of The Stoudamire team and other departments to organize special events, pop-ups, and speaking series for children and their families
- Assisting to set up and break down for classes and events
